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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### KENDALL COUNTY:

Court Watch encourages the County Court system to educate judges hearing domestic violence cases in the dynamics of domestic violence.

We continue to receive monthly updates of domestic trials from the Kendall County states attorney's office. Kendall County case continuation dates are reported by observers, so these cases can be tracked and observed.

Kendall County bond call is now held at 1:00 PM in room 114. Court watch will be observing this process and reporting on domestic violence cases.

Sadly, a recent domestic violence offender, with a lengthy history of abuse against the same victim, was released on a recognizance bond. A few days later the offender killed the victim, plus another person, then took his own life. It is our understanding that the victim was cooperating the prosecution of this crime, and utilizing the services of Mutual Ground.

We urge the use of the sound system and tables in room 114 for domestic violence case proceedings. When victims and family members are sitting in the gallery, they simply cannot hear the proceedings when they are conducted at the bench. This should include the presentation of plea agreements by attorneys.

Recently there were a couple of judge changes, including a retirement announcement and an appointment of a new judge.

### KANE COUNTY:

We urge the County court system to return to a designated court room for felony domestic violence cases. We are hopeful to hear that the Kane County Sherriff is working to partially reinstate the GPS monitoring program by September 2019. Unfortunately, there will not be enough funding to include domestic violence offenders until the middle of 2020. Many others in the domestic violence field recommend both of these practices because this is a specialized crime unlike most crimes.

We are still waiting for a real education program for judges on domestic violence. We hope this situation can be addressed very soon for the sake of the victims of domestic violence. They are the ones who suffer. They are the ones you are committed to protect.

We continue to receive a download of information from Kane County regarding domestic cases.

### QUARTERLY RESULTS:

During second quarter of 2019 a total of 96 observations were reported. (Kane County: 42 reports; Kendall County: 54 reports) Several cases were observed and reported on by multiple observers. Court Watch encourages this practice because it provides differing opinions on these cases. Observation outcomes breakdown as follows:

#### Kane County:

- 21 - cases were continued.
- 4 - cases were dismissed.
- 2 - cases resulted in a guilty verdict.
- 2 - cases resulted in a DV guilty plea.
- 0 - cases resulted in a not guilty verdict.
- 3 - OP requests were granted.
- 5 - OP requests were denied.
- 1 - OP request – injunction granted.
- 1 - VOP denied.
- 1 – Bond call DV case was observed.
- 1 – case was closed

Kendall County:

- 14 - cases were continued.
- 5 - cases were dismissed.
- 7 - cases resulted in a guilty verdict.
- 2 - cases resulted in a plea to DB charge.
- 2 - cases resulted in plea to common battery.
- 3 - cases resulted in a not guilty verdict.
- 5 - sentencing hearings were observed.
- 11 - DB bond call cases were observed.
- 1 - order of protection was granted.
- 4 - DV case motions were observed.

The following pages display the scores given to the Judges observed and supporting comments. Note: Judges that were observed and reported on only one time during the quarter are not included in this report.

The attached files display the details taken from the observation reports for Kane and Kendall Counties.

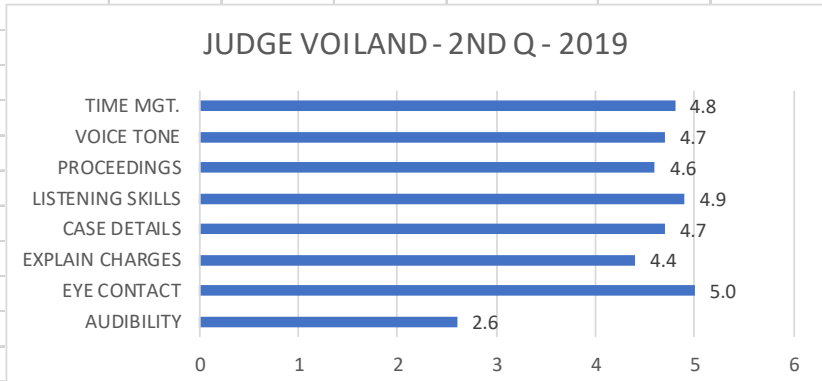

Judge offered court watchers to use jury box. Since tables were used they declined offer.

Overall same problems with hearing the Judge, He seems to go quiet during trials.

Judge has good control of courtroom, one case had defedant who was loud and vulger.

Observer was unable to hear proceedings or to score the judge in most areas.

After the trial ASA Jirasek asked me if I had any questions. This was very helpful.

Judge allowed me to sit in jury box. I could hear the proceedings.

Audibility score is a 5 because observer sat in jury box.

When tables are used the proceedings can be heard in the gallery.

There was a lot of commotion around the bench.

Cannot hear judge so it is difficult to score the judge in many areas.

Completely impossible to hear what is going on.

Video out of service, bond call held in person. Could not hear.

Judge patient with defense, allowed time to meet with defendant.

Judge left bench twice without explanation that could be heard.

I was surprised that there were also traffic violations on the docket.
