## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### KENDALL COUNTY:

Court Watch encourages the County Court system to educate judges hearing domestic violence cases in the dynamics of domestic violence.

We continue to receive monthly updates of domestic trials from the Kendall County states attorney's office. Kendall County case continuation dates are reported by observers, so these cases can be tracked and observed.

Kendall County bond call is now held at 1:00 PM in room 114. Court watch will be observing this process and reporting on domestic violence cases.

We are pleased to hear the announcement of the establishment of the Kendall County Domestic Violence Response Team. We look forward to working with the Team members.

We urge the use of the sound system and tables in room 114 for domestic violence case proceedings. That said, this situation has improved greatly. Thank you to the currently assigned judges.

### KANE COUNTY:

We are pleased with announcement of the establishment of the Kane County Crisis Intervention Team. The Team Commander recently spoke at a Court Watch general meeting. We look forward to working with members of the Team.

We urge the County court system to return to a designated court room for felony domestic violence cases. We are hopeful to hear that the Kane County Sherriff is working to partially reinstate the GPS monitoring program by September 2019. Unfortunately, there will not be enough funding to include domestic violence offenders until the middle of 2020. Many others in the domestic violence field recommend both of these practices because this is a specialized crime unlike most crimes.

We are still waiting for a real education program for judges on domestic violence. We hope this situation can be addressed very soon for the sake of the victims of domestic violence. They are the ones who suffer. They are the ones you are committed to protect.

We continue to receive a download of information from Kane County regarding domestic cases.

### QUARTERLY RESULTS:

During third quarter of 2019 a total of 117 observations were reported. (Kane County: 20 reports; Kendall County: 97 reports) Several cases were observed and reported on by multiple observers. Court Watch encourages this practice because it provides differing opinions on these cases. Observation outcomes breakdown as follows

#### Kane County:

- 15 - cases were continued.
- 3 - cases resulted in a guilty verdict.
- 1 - order of protection was granted.
- 1 - order of protection was denied

#### Kendall County:

- 70 - cases were continued.
- 13 - cases resulted in a guilty verdict.
- 6 - cases resulted in a not guilty verdict.
- 1 - order of protection was granted.
- 5 - cases were dismissed
- 2 - cases were closed

The following pages display the scores given to the Judges observed and supporting comments. Note: Judges that were reported on fewer than three times during the quarter are not included in this report.

The attached files display the details taken from the observation reports for Kane and Kendall Counties.

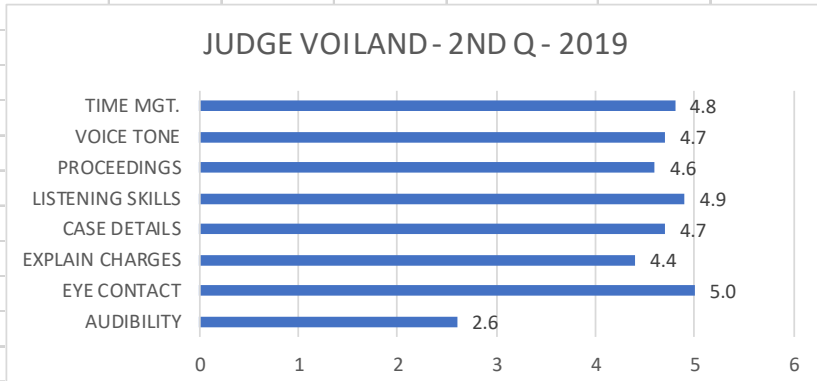

Judge patient with defense, allowed time to meet with defendant.

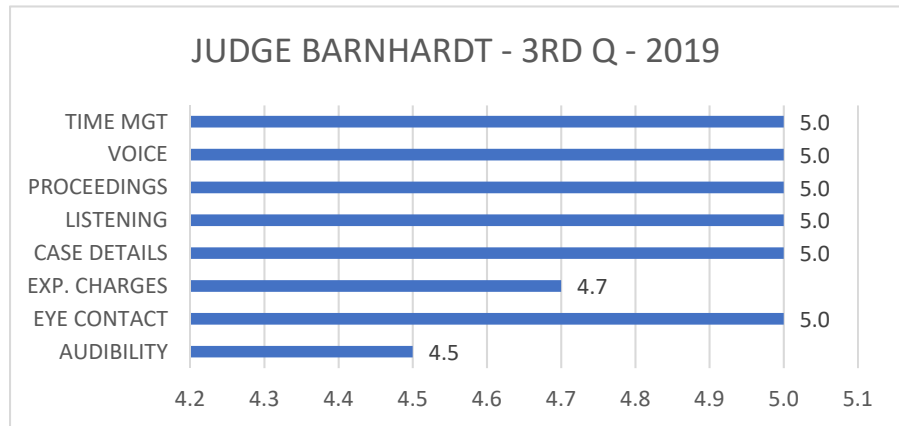
Judge left bench twice without explanation that could be heard.

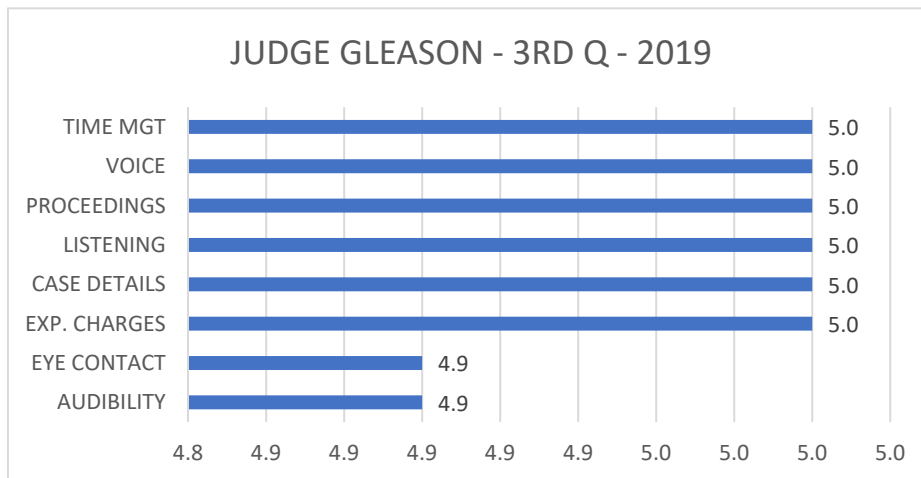

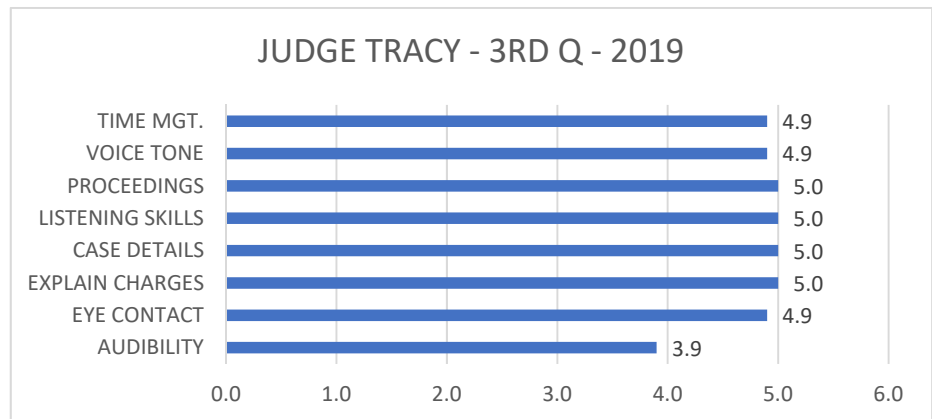
